Just before sunset, houseboat is tied up for the night & dinner is served on-board. Overnight stay in Alleppey Houseboat.



Day 7: Alleppey – Kovalam (160 km/04 hrs approx.)

Disembark from the houseboat in Alleppey and drive towards Kovalam. Upon arrival check in to the hotel and relax. Evening reach to sea side of Kovalam beach and explore Hawa beach, Lighthouse beach and others. Overnight stay in Kovalam.

Day 8: Kovalam

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Day 9: Kovalam – Kanyakumari (90 km/03 hrs approx.)

Today check out from hotel and drive to Kanyakumari. It is located in neighbouring state of Tamil Nadu, the Southernmost tip of Indian mainland. Upon arrival check in to the hotel. Later go for city tour to see Vivekananda Rock memorial, located 100 meters from the shore and is one of the major tourist attractions in Kanyakumari. Here the Thiruvalluvar Statue is one of the largest statues in Asia. Then visit Kanyakumari Temple, also referred to as Bhagvaty Amman Temple and is one of the 108 Shakti Peetha in Hindu mythology. The temple is one of the major Hindu temples across India and is mentioned in almost all the ancient Hindu scriptures. In the evening see the mesmerizing sunset over the ocean and confluence of 3 sea –Arabian Sea, Indian ocean and Bay of Bengal. Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 10: Kovalam – Trivandrum - Departure

Post breakfast check out from hotel and drive to Trivandrum and upon reaching go for a half day city tour. Visit Padmanabhaswamy Temple (from outside for a photo-stop) a heritage marvel and famous for excavated gold stacks. Also visit Horse Palace, Napier Museum, Sree Chitra Art gallery. Later, timely transfer to Trivandrum International Airport to board on to your flight for onward destination with beautiful memories of your tour.
