GTMT-01 Golden Triangle - Ex: Delhi/Jaipur
Duration: 04 Nights 05 Days
Places Covered: DELHI | AGRA | FATEHPUR SIKRI | JAIPUR

Day 1: Arrival Delhi – Overnight Stay

On arrival at Delhi Airport/Railway Station, our driver will meet and greet you with traditional Indian welcome NAMASTE. Meet with your driver and drive directly to city.
